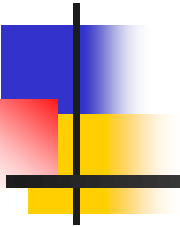

Our results

- *Our numbers:*
 - 37 countries all over Europe
 - 34 countries got some answers
 - 851 participants
 - Turkey(198), Serbia(75), Croatia(65)

More facts

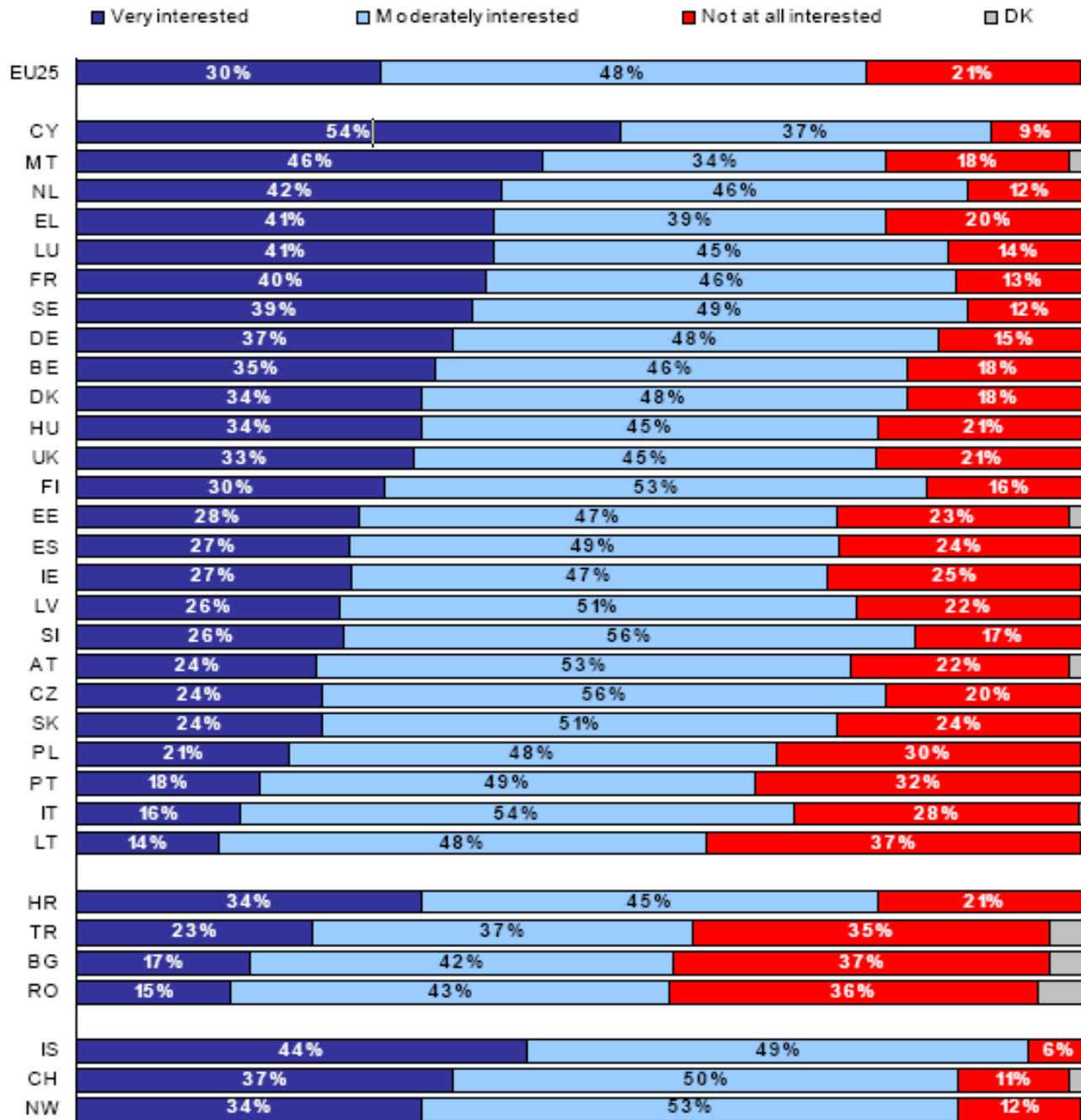
- Prof. Nitza Geri – IOU, multimedia department
 - Analysis of online courses (10 courses, more than 700 students) shows that less than 10% of the users willing to answer questions or participate in forums/discussion groups.
- Prof. Alexandra Cristea, Head of the Innovative Computing research group at the CS Department, Durham University
 - (7 courses, 27 runs, 293461 students in total) the average number of users who identify themselves by gender is 8.71%, ranging per course from 5.95% to 13.83%.
 - Age looks similar: identify themselves by age = 8.5% on average, and ranging over courses - 5.87% to 13.46%



Elzbieta's data

- Facebook groups:
 - 1. English Teacher's market 10548 members
 - 2. English teachers 20667 members
 - 3. English teachers - IATEFL 1032 members
- My students:
 - extramural students 9 out of 15 visited the link to the questionnaire on Moodle
 - daily students 34 out of 91 visited the link to the questionnaire on Moodle
 - No information about how many of them actually answered.
- Private school teachers who answered the questions for the pilot 2 out of 15 teachers answered
- Personal Facebook network 71 friends
 - 3 people shared and answered.
